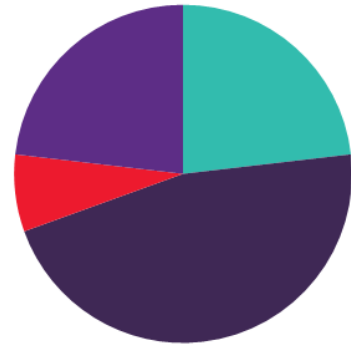

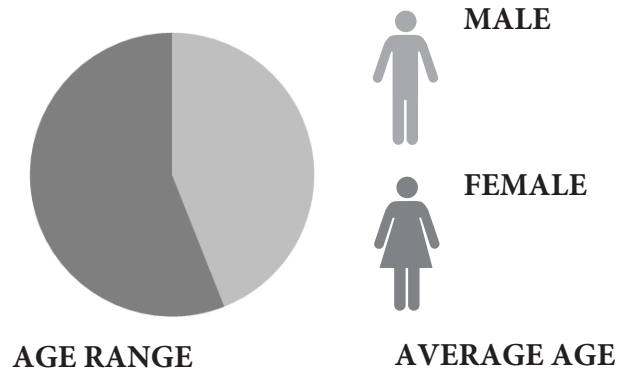
UNIQUE FACTS
