

MP II Highlights for Applicants

MP II Principles

- MP II applicants **MUST** submit applications only through CASPRweb and **MUST** accept unfilled positions only through MP II until the conclusion of MP II.
 - Applicants **CANNOT** use any means other than CASPR web to apply to and contact programs. Applicants may apply **ONLY** to programs participating in MP II.

Applicants and individuals/entities acting on behalf of applicants CANNOT contact programs until the program initiates contact. Such conduct is a CASPR violation and will be investigated.

- Non-CASPR applicants **CANNOT** apply to **ANY** CASPR participating programs until after MP II concludes.
- Positions offered/accepted during MP II establish a binding commitment enforced by the CASPR participation agreement.

How MP II Works

- Applicants learn whether they are matched or unmatched on Monday of Match Week. Applicants who are matched can**NOT** participate in MP II or have access to the List of Unfilled Programs.
- Applicants review the available unfilled programs and express preferences by applying to programs using CASPRweb. By default, CASPRweb lists all unfilled programs in an applicant's selected programs list. If an applicant does NOT wish to apply to a program/s in that list, the applicant must remove the program from the selected programs list and move it to the available programs list. Applicants do not enter rank order or preference lists during MP II.
- Programs review CASPR applications and express preferences with rank lists of applicants to whom they would like to offer a position.
 - Program directors cannot ask applicants to indicate whether they will accept an offer if one is extended through MP II.
- Positions are offered through the CASPRweb system to applicants in order of a program's preference list and according to the number of unfilled positions remaining in the program during each round.
 - Applicants can receive multiple offers in any MP II round.
 - Applicants have 2 hours in which to accept, decline or let offers expire.
 - Offers accepted automatically make applicants ineligible for a position in another program.
 - Offers rejected/expired will **NOT** be extended again.
- At the conclusion of MP II, any unfilled positions are posted on the AACPM website here.
- **ALL** applicants who remain unmatched at the conclusion of MP II, including non-CASPR participants, may apply to any positions listed on the website.

Applicant Eligibility for MP II:

To participate in MP II, applicants **MUST** have registered for the current CASPR match cycle and be unmatched **AND** able to enter residency education on July 1 in the year of the mtch.
