

**Student Availability for Clerkship Rotations
Status as of 8/3/2020**

School	Student Availability
AZPod	Students are participating in clinical rotations unless the hospital cancels the rotation. In the event of hospital cancelations AZPod provides office based rotations and virtual clinical experiences.
BUSPM	Students resume rotations effective June 1 and are operating under a new Barry University Communicable Disease Return to In-Person Experiential Learning Policy.
CSPM	Effective June 1, students will be voluntarily able to attend any clinical rotation or clerkship that has opened for student participation with the following conditions: students may not treat any patients with known active COVID-19, students must wear appropriate PPE and students must follow rules regarding hand sanitization, SARS CoV-2 testing and self-quarantine (for potential illness or recent out-of-state travel). Students who opt out of attending a clinical rotation for whatever reason will be given a remote learning experience. Students who opt out may also elect to take an extended leave of absence from the CSPM program.
DMU-CPMS	Students are permitted to participate in clinical rotations unless circumstances change. Re-Entry Guidelines are still in effect.
KSUCPM	Students will resume clinical rotations with COVID precautions on July 6. All external rotations are governed by the policies of the medical institutions.
NYCPM	Students will resume clinical rotations with appropriate Covid precautions on July 6.
SCPM	A few clinical rotations will continue to be suspended through the end of July. However, all students will be rotating at hospitals/health systems that are willing to train students.
TUSPM	Student participation in clinical training is voluntary. Students are not to participate in the care of or knowingly be exposed to known or suspected COVID patients. If an exposure incident occurs students are to follow the self-isolation/quarantine and testing protocols of the host institution.
WUCPM	Effective July 1, 2020, students are participating in clinical rotations at sites that allow them to continue. It is understood that appropriate PPE will be available for them.
